Readings: Mi 5:1-4a; Ps 80:2-3, 15-16, 18-19; Heb 10:5-10; Lk 1:39-45

PSALM: Lord, make us turn to you; let us see your face and we shall be saved.

Gospel Reflection: Lk 1:39-45

The Gospel of Luke 1:39-45 invites us to reflect on the joyful anticipation of Christ's coming. Mary's visit to Elizabeth is more than a familial encounter; it is a meeting filled with the presence of God and the joy that His coming brings. Elizabeth's exclamation, "Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb," reminds us that Mary's faith and trust in God made her the bearer of the Savior.


